

# The African Children's Choir is coming to Trinity!

Mark your calendars now for this exciting weekend! The choir will be performing at Trinity on **Saturday, October 30<sup>th</sup> at 16.00**. They will also be participating in the Sunday morning worship service at Trinity. We need about 12-15 families willing to host 2-3 children (or 2 children and a chaperone) for Friday afternoon, 29 October through Monday morning, 1 November. Trinity has hosted the choir before and it is a truly blessed experience to be able to participate in the lives of these orphans.



The African Children's Choir is made up of some of the neediest and most vulnerable children in their countries. Many have lost one or both parents to poverty or disease. The African Children's Choir helps these children break away from the everyday cycle of poverty and hopelessness. The 24 singers selected each

year come from some of Africa's poorest countries such as Kenya, Uganda and Rwanda. Children selected to tour will spend approximately five months at the Choir Training Academy in Kampala, Uganda. Here the children learn the songs and dances, attend school, play and attend Sunday School at a local church.

The choir is essentially an ambassador choir, touring the world to heighten awareness of the needs of the children in Africa. Donations received from the tour go directly to help sponsor the children's education.
