Trinity Lutheran is an international English-speaking Christian community located in Frankfurt am Main, Germany. We are a very welcoming home to people of all ages and already more than 16+ nations.

OUR MISSION, welcoming people from all nations and sharing Jesus Christ in our community.

WHO WE ARE: Our congregation is very friendly, open, and welcoming, represented by 16+ nationalities/cultures, and several Christian denominations. We offer communion to baptized Christians. We regularly baptize infants and adults into the Christian Faith. We have an ongoing changeover of active membership. Trinity is extremely active and family oriented.

For a congregation of our size, we aspire to have strong music and children/youth programs. We have a core group of members dedicated to our music programs. Long-Term continuity of leadership of church programs is challenged by the transient nature of our congregation. - Prepares anthems for special services, when necessary (i.e. Advent, Lent, Baptisms, Weddings, Funerals)
- Warms-up choir and conducts music for Sunday worship services and other special services
- Organizes music in the choral library (currently with assistance)
