RESPONSIBILITIES

- Provides music for weekly services and special services (primarily on organ). This includes a Prelude, Offertory, Postlude, hymns, and music during Communion in the weekly worship services. Music in both classical and contemporary styles will be performed.
- Accompanies the choir when singing during Sunday and special services (i.e. Advent, Lent, Baptisms, Weddings, Funerals)
- Occasionally attends and accompanies weekly choir rehearsals on Wednesday evenings
- Arranges for a substitute organist/pianist when required
- Coordinates with Pastor to select music for weekly and special worship services
- Prepares and controls the music program budget; prepares monthly invoices for paid musicians
- Arranges for regular piano and organ maintenance (coordination through Director of Music Ministry/ Church Office)
